

Règlement Interclubs Juniors

1. Organization:

The event called “61th Tour du Condroz” is organized by UC SERAING according to the UCI and Belgian Cycling regulations. It takes place on Sunday June 29, starting at 3:10 p.m.

2. Type of event:

The event is reserved for athletes in the Junior category. It is included in the national calendar Belgian Cycling in class JUN 1.14 IC and counts for the LOTTO-Belgian Junior Cup.

3. Participation:

The event is reserved for the 25 teams selected by the RLVB road commission. He will not have wild card this year. Teams will be made up of a maximum of 6 riders or a minimum of 4 riders.

4. Permanence:

- All departure formalities will be done at Hall Omnisports IPES Av. du Centenaire 240 à 4102 Ougrée
 - Confirmation of starters and collection of bibs by team managers is done at the open from 12:10 p.m. to 12:55 p.m.
 - The Sports Directors meeting will take place at 1:10 p.m.
 - The signing of the start sheet and the presentation of the teams will take place on the podium at the finish line on avenue du Centenaire from 1:55 p.m. to 2:55 p.m. following the order given by the organizer.
 - The arrival desk will be held at the same location.
 - The Race Director will be named Christian Gilon rue du Bassin, 8 in 4800 VERVIERS

5. Registration procedure:

At least 20 days before the event, the team sends the names of the sports director, riders and reserves in the online registration module (comp.kbwb-rlvb.com). The team and the organizer receive a confirmation by email.

72 hours before the start time of the event, the team sends the names of the starters and two replacements in the online registration module.

At the latest 15 minutes before the meeting of sports directors, the team sports director must confirm to the College of Commissaires the identity of the participating riders.

6. Radio-tour:

Race information is broadcast on frequency 160.10625 channel 2.

7. Technical cars:

- Each team has the right to put a support vehicle in the race. The order of cars will be established by drawing lots during the briefing, according to the procedure of article 4 of the rules of the Belgian junior Lotto-cup.
- On arrival, the cars of the Sports Directors and others (with the exception of the vehicles of the members of the jury of Commissioners) are required to use the diversion set up by the organizer.
- A pass will also be issued to “caregiver” assistance vehicles
- The neutral technical assistance service is provided by two neutral cars and 1 motorcycle.

8. Medical assistance:

two ambulances and a doctor will follow the race.

9. Refueling:

- Refueling will be authorized from technical cars after 30 km up to 20 km before arrival and following the terms set out in articles 2.3.026 and 2.3.027 of the UCI regulations.
- Waste collection areas per km 33,7 – 78 – 104,6 – 112,9

10. Deadlines:

- Any rider arriving within a time limit exceeding 8% of the winner's time is no longer retained for the general classification. The deadline may be increased in exceptional circumstances by the College commissioners, in consultation with the Organizer
- Elimination times in the race are set at five minutes behind the main peloton. Runners, and especially late runners, are reminded that the highway code must be respected.

11. Rankings:

- Individual ranking of the event.

- The interclub ranking is established on the basis of the addition of the three best individual times of each team. In the event of a tie, the teams are decided by adding the places obtained by their 3 best runners. In the event of a new tie, the teams will be decided by the place of their best runner.
- The classification of the Montagne G.P.M. will be established by adding the points awarded on all 5 listed hills. The first three runners will receive 5, 3 and 1 points respectively. In the event of a tie, the ranking at the finish will be taken into account. To be eligible for the GPM ranking prize, competitors must complete the event on time.

12. Prizes:

- The prizes will be paid to the Office directly after the rankings have been established.

13. Anti-doping:

- The anti-doping regulations of the UCI, Belgian Cycling and the French Community apply in accordance with the provisions of Belgian law.
- The anti-doping control will take place at Hall Omnisports IPES Av. du Centenaire 240 à 4102 Ougrée.

14. Protocol:

The first three classified riders at the finish, the first three classified riders in the classification of the Mountain and the leader of the Belgian Cup are required to appear at the protocol ceremony which will be held at the finish line.

15. Environment:

Trash cans will be placed in the departure zone, in the arrival zone as well as in the cloakrooms. We ask that you respect the environment by telling your runners to avoid to throw packaging and cans into nature and to respect the areas of refueling, as well as waste areas set up by the Organizer.

16. Penalties:

The BelgianCycling penalty scale is the only one applicable. All cases not provided for herein regulations will be decided by the College of Commissioners in accordance with the provisions in use at the UCI or BelgianCycling.
